



## Onondaga Lake Community Participation Lead Community Participation Working Group (CPWG)

*Meetings: First Thursday of the Month, 4-6 p.m*

**Mission:** To provide for community involvement in the cleanup of Onondaga Lake throughout all phases of the lake bottom remedial design and construction process so that the public is informed and has opportunities to contribute information, opinions, perspectives and recommendations about the program.

**Who we are:** The CPWG is a voluntary group consisting of citizens, community leaders, public officials, and conservation and environmental group leaders. CPWG meetings are open to the public.

The CPWG is self-governing and works independently of the DEC and Honeywell. Specifically, the CPWG:

- Meets monthly to review Onondaga Lake Bottom remediation progress;
- Gathers information on significant project milestones by requesting speakers and presentations from Project team;
- Makes recommendations to DEC to create site specific CPWG(s) such as habitat, dredging and capping, and sediment consolidation area (SCA); and
- Focuses on outreach, communication and citizen participation aspects of the remediation program by reviewing and making recommendations on project progress, outreach and citizen participation activities, and facilitating communication with the public.
